

## **MATERIALS REQUIRED AS ADVANCED PREPARATION**

Annual Merit Badge Seminar - March 19, 2010 (\* = Eagle-required Merit Badges)

(It is BSA policy that requirements not be added to nor detracted from the BSA merit badges. It is not the intent of the Troops 222 / 22 Merit Badge Seminar organizers to in any way modify the requirements of the merit badges offered. In conducting a seminar and assisting several Scouts to complete a merit badge simultaneously, it is not feasible in many instances to work with each Scout orally to complete the requirements for that badge. Worksheets are used as a tool to enable the Scouts to complete the merit badge at the seminar. For a worksheet you may go to <http://www.meritbadge.org>

### **Chemistry**

- 1) Bring a 2 liter plastic bottle and an eye dropper.
- 2) Learn what a material safety data sheet (MSDS) is why it is used. 3) Obtain an MSDS for both a paint and an insecticide. Compare and discuss the toxicity, disposal, and safe-handling sections for these two common household products.
- 3) Complete one activity under #7 (a, b, c, or d.)

### **Citizenship in the Community\***

Do requirements 2a, 3a, 3b, 4a, 4b, 5, 7a, 7b, 7c & 8. Bring presentation (#8) to show to group. You must come prepared. (Make sure you're using the new requirements!)

### **Citizenship in the Nation\***

Contact information will be provided after registration.

Do requirements 1,2,4,5 & 7 and be prepared to discuss #6. Contact counselor to discuss your topic.

### **Citizenship in the World\***

Do requirements 2, 3, 4,5a & 6. Bring written descriptions for each of the prerequisite requirements and be prepared to discuss them. Study merit badge pamphlet.

### **Emergency Preparedness\***

Bring evidence of completion of #1. Do requirements #2b & c, 6b & c, 7, 8 & 9. Study merit badge pamphlet & be prepared to discuss.

### **Family Life\***

Contact information will be provided after registration.

Discuss requirement #2 with parents or guardian. For #3 bring a list of chores with a record for however long you've done them (need 90 days for full credit). Call counselor for the approval of project for #4 and bring reports of the project for #4 and #5. Complete requirement #6b. Please bring your Family Life merit badge book with you.

### **Fingerprinting**

No advanced preparation required

### **First Aid\***

Bring evidence of completion of all first aid requirements through First Class. For #2b, bring completed home first aid kit. Study merit badge book.

### **Genealogy**

Bring all the information you can find for #2 and #3. Bring evidence of interview for #4. Bring one document for #5 (photocopy is fine). Do #7 (bring journal if you choose #7b).

### **Orienteering**

*Be prepared to discuss all requirements.*

Bring evidence of completion for requirements 5,6b, 7, 8 and 9.

### **Reading**

Bring all evidence of completion for all requirements and be ready to discuss them with the counselor.
